2009-2010 SCHOOL COORDINATOR GUIDE

Program Dates

The Martin's Advantages for Education program will run for 25 weeks to give your school plenty of time to rally community support. Supporter sign-up begins Monday, August 17, 2009 and point accrual begins on Thursday, October 15, 2009 and continues through Monday, April 12, 2010. The deadline to place orders is Saturday, May 1, 2010.

Point System

We've divided this year's 25 week program into five periods of five weeks as shown below:

- Period 1: October 15, 2009 through November 19, 2009
- Period 2: November 20, 2009 through December 25, 2009
- Period 3: December 26, 2009 through January 30, 2010
- Period 4: January 31, 2010 through March 7, 2010
- Period 5: March 8, 2010 through April 12, 2010

Shortly after each period ends, the number of points your school earned will be posted on our website and sent to each coordinator who provides an email address.

Points will accumulate until the program ends on Monday, April 12, 2010. Schools may order as soon as enough points are accumulated for the desired awards.

We will post the number of points your school earned at the end of each period as well as a cumulative list of total points. You may redeem points at any time during the program or wait until the end to place your orders. The deadline to place orders for the 2009-2010 school year is Saturday, May 1, 2010.

If you do not have access to a computer, you may call **1-800-999-7750** and one of our program coordinators will assist in activating your school.

Communicating Your School ID Number is Essential

The goal of your 2009-2010 Martin's Advantages for Education program should be seeking new supporters by communicating your four digit School ID Number. Remember, the success of your program lies in announcing your School ID Number to the community. To receive credit for each and every purchase your supporters make using their Martin's Advantage Card, they must be registered using your School ID Number. Classroom Posters

School Hall Poster

This large poster should be placed in a high-visibility area to attract attention. Be sure to write your School ID Number in the space provided. This number is essential. Each of your supporters must use this number to insure your school receives points for their purchases. When a customer initially signs up to donate their points to your school using your School ID Number, each subsequent purchase made by that customer using their Martin's Advantage Card is automatically credited with points to your school throughout the duration of the program.

Award Labels

Press Release

When our program coordinator receives your school's order, the award point value will be subtracted from your school's account. The educational awards your school earned will be delivered in six to eight weeks.

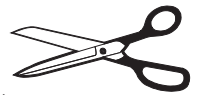
